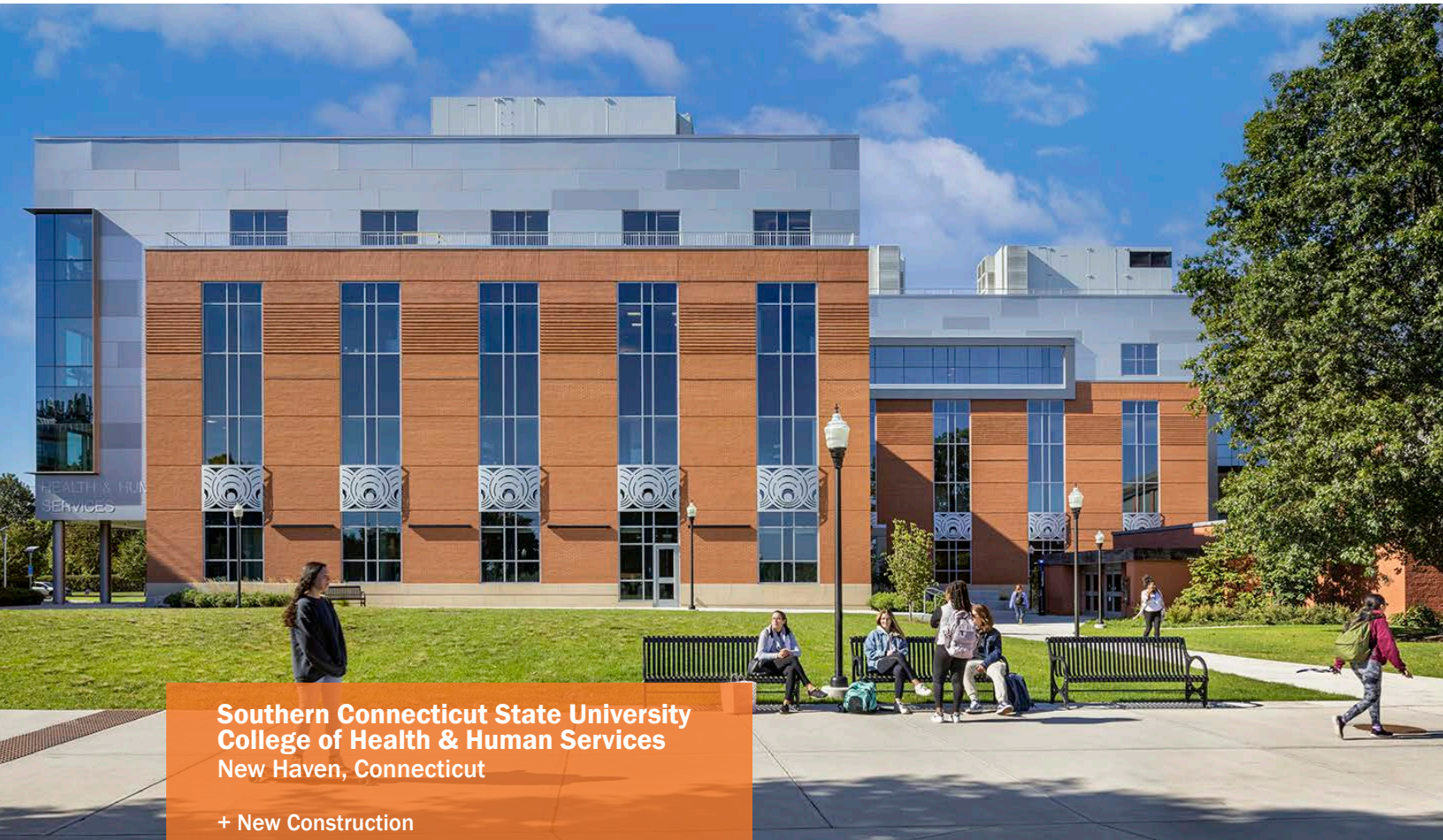


Our Work

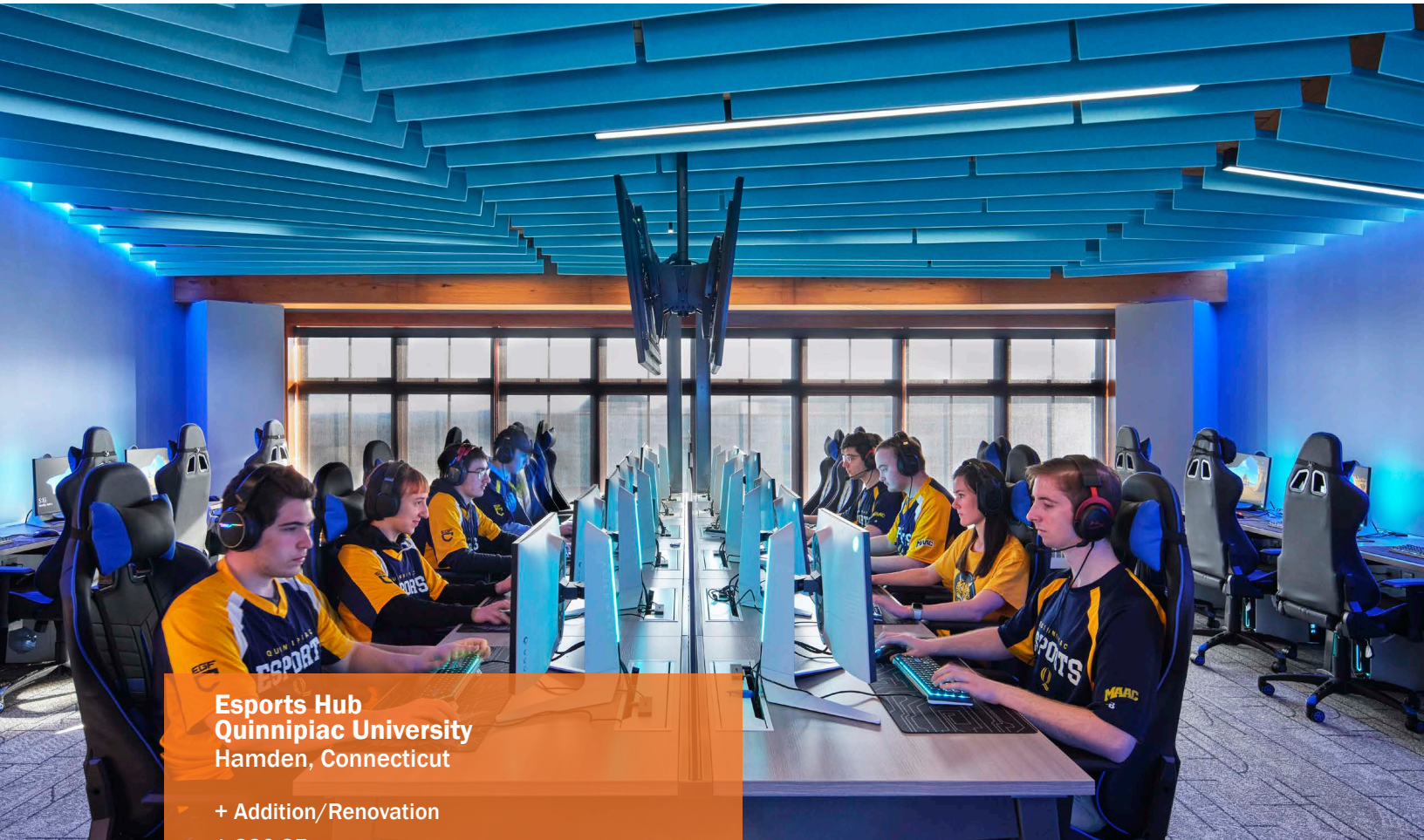

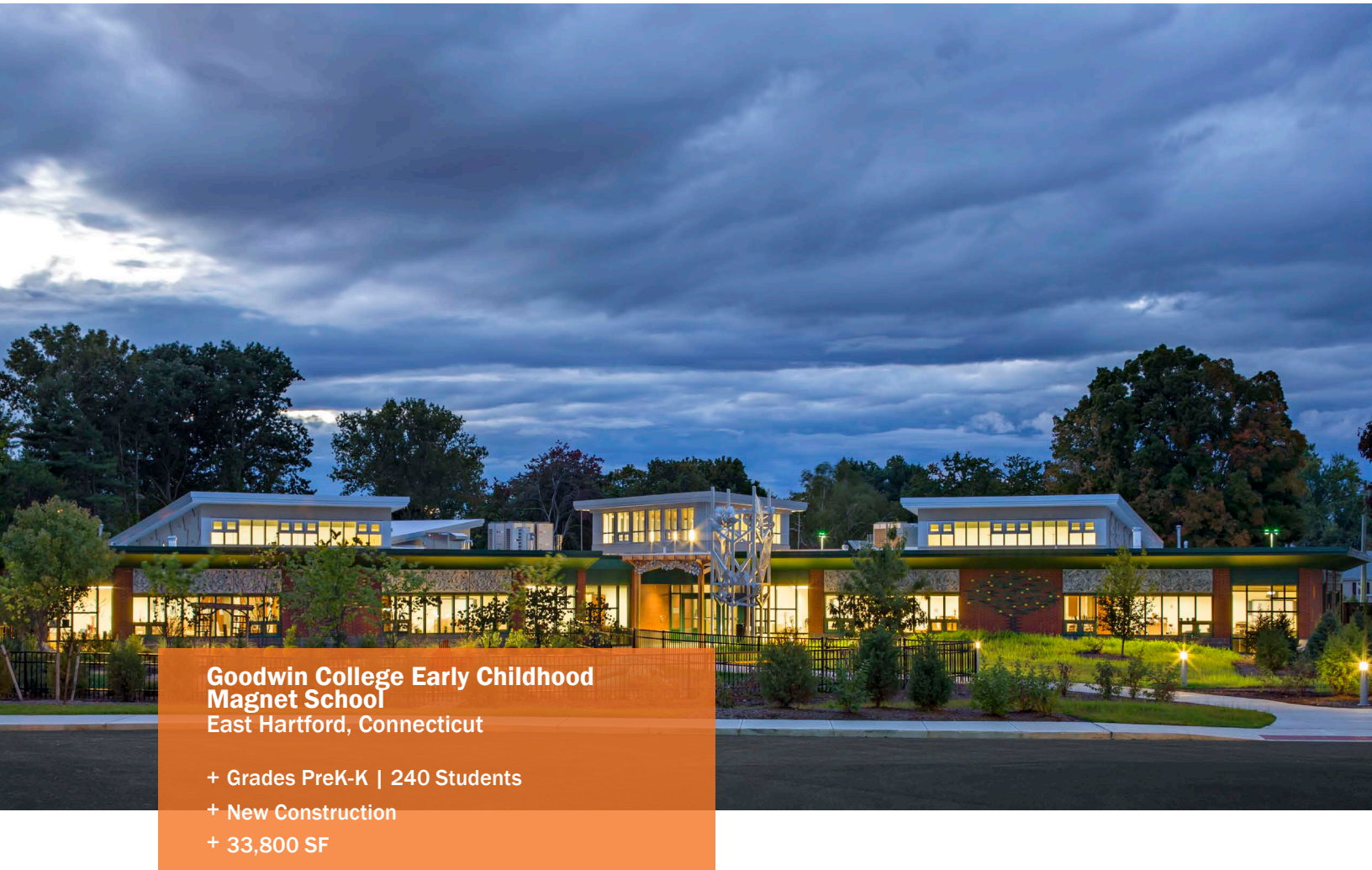


Sandy Hook Elementary School
